EMILY C. PRUDDEN – a friend from the other side

The CCSC receives support from several friends from the Superior Realm, protecting the members of the institution who are living in the same vibration of Jesus' Gospel and also in spreading Spiritism in North Carolina. One of these friends is Emily Catherine Prudden (1832-1917), an educator and missionary who established fifteen primary and secondary schools in western North Carolina in the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

Although almost deaf and hampered by arthritis, she listed her personal calling in establishing schools for low income communities. Usually, after operating the schools for a few years, she would hand them over to a church to run it and set out to found another.

Prudden resided in Hickory, NC, at the time of his death, and she was buried in Orange County, Connecticut.

She was recognized as a key figure in the history of the development of Education for Women and to African-Americans in the South.

In his praise, Congregation Minister George Dickerman estimated that more than 10,000 students had passed through her schools.
